

How to start Windows 10 in "Safe Mode with Networking"


- 1. Press Windows logo key + I on your keyboard to open Settings. If that doesn't work, select the **Start** button, then select **Settings ②**.
- 2. Select Update & Security C > Recovery 5

Open Recovery Settings

- 3. Under Advanced startup, select Restart now.
- After your PC restarts to the Choose an option screen, select Troubleshoot > Advanced options > Startup
 Settings > Restart. You may be asked to enter your <u>BitLocker recovery key</u> (See https://support.microsoft.com/en-gb/help/4026181)









5. After your PC restarts, you will see a list of options. Select 5 or press F5 for Safe Mode with Networking.

After you have carried out any tests in Safe Mode simply restart your device to return to normal*

- *If windows automatically starts in Safe Mode, check settings:
- 2. Type msconfig in the Open box and then select OK.
- 3. Select the **Boot tab**.
- 4. Under **Boot options**, clear the **Safe boot** checkbox, click **OK** and **restart** the computer.
